

Children's Day Montessori's Summer Program offers children the opportunity to develop self-confidence, learn new skills, gain independence, make new friends, and enjoy summer activities both inside the classroom and outdoors.

This year we will be having three sessions. Each session will feature activities, creations, speakers, and presentations related to the theme of each month.

Session One: June 5<sup>th</sup>- 30<sup>th</sup>- Composting and Recycling Session Two: July 5<sup>th</sup> – July 30<sup>th</sup> – Tending your Garden Session Three: July 31<sup>st</sup> - August 25<sup>th</sup> – Bees – How they impact our gardens

**The last day of summer school is Friday, August 25th**. The week of August 28th –September 1st will be orientation for new children and therefore we will be unable to offer childcare that week.

## NOTE: WE WILL BE HAVING LUNCH AT 12:00 AFTER PARENTS HAVE PICKED UP CHILDREN WITH NOON SCHEDULES.

We will be offering pizza for lunch this summer on Wednesdays. The cost will be \$5 per day. Sign up your child weekly if you want them to have pizza.

## **Other Items Needed**

- Reusable water bottle to be kept at school
- A labeled reusable bag to transport lunches and other items to and from school
- An **extra set of clothes** (*including socks and undergarments*) to be kept at school in case of spills or accidents
- A lightweight jacket for morning outside works;
- A pair of **inside shoes** that stay at school for your child to change into each day
- Outside shoes must have backs on them and an enclosed toe—FOR SAFETY REASONS: PLEASE NO FLIP FLOP SANDALS.
- Sunscreen: Each child, or family, will need their own can of aerosol sunscreen and stick sunscreen for faces to keep at school. Please apply sunscreen to your child in the morning and staff will reapply sunscreen in the afternoon.
- Lunch box, with icepack, if your child is staying for lunch / all day.
- Napping children will need **a blanket and pillow** that stays at school and is sent home on weekends for laundering.
- Any **outstanding paperwork**. Children, newly enrolled at CDM, need immunization records on the first day they are attending and a physical on file within 30 days after they start.
